It gives me immense pleasure to welcome you all to our Founder's Day this evening and I feel honoured in presenting the Annual Report of Pushpalata Schools for the academic year 2018-19.

Our journey has been long from our significant start, way back in 1986. The vision and dream of our founder Thiru. Palai N. Shanmugam has flourished the Pushpalata Educational Centre into five schools - Pushpalata Matriculation Higher Secondary School - the first to introduce Montessori system of education in Tirunelveli, Pushpalata Vidya Mandir - the first CBSE Senior Secondary School in Tirunelveli, Pushpalata British International School - the first IGCSE School in Tirunelveli, Pushpalata Primary School, MITRA - A centre for autistic children. Today Pushpalata Schools stand tall with 5152 students, 345 teachers and 181 nonteaching staff under its wings. I would like to place on record my gratitude to our dear Correspondent, Mrs. Pushpalata Pooranan, whose dynamic leadership and commitment has made the schools reach the peak of accomplishment.

Today, Pushpalata Schools has taken shape as guiding light in the Educational scenario for students, teachers and parents alike. I take this opportunity to lay before you the yearly updates of our academic and co-scholastic achievements, our activities and honours, of the academic year 2018 - 19. And I am indebted to God Almighty for all the bountiful success that we have frequently enjoyed.

I. BOARD EXAMINATION RESULTS:

PUSHPALATA MATRIC. HR. SEC. SCHOOL: CLASS XII RESULTS

Rakesh N. is the school topper with 560, followed by Jeyanthi Lakshmi with 557 and Sakthi Devi A. S. with 556. Six students have scored centums in Computer Science and one in Accountancy.

CLASS X RESULTS

Santhiya I. is the topper with 483, followed by Sriram Vignesh with 480 and Aruna A. S. with 476. One student has scored centum in Social Science.

PUSHPALATA VIDYA MANDIR: CLASS XII RESULTS

In the All India Senior Secondary School Examinations 2019, Siva Subramanian A. scored the first mark - 480/500 followed by Guru Vignesh A. M. - 479 and Hrileka K. B. - 478 marks. Shreya Pooranan has scored centum in Economics and Yogesh Kirubha S. in Informatics Practices. 65 students have secured A1 grade in English, 42 in Physics, 36 in Biology, 28 in Chemistry, 15 in Business Studies, 12 in Maths, 9 in Computer Studies, 6 in Economics, 5 in Accountancy and 2 in Informatics Practices.

CLASS X:

Out of the 137 students who appeared for the Board exams, 128 have scored above 400/500. 92 students in Science, 76 in English, 74 in Social Studies, 72 in Maths, 26 in Tamil, 14 in Hindi and 1 in French have secured the A1 grade. 93% of the students have secured distinctions.

Kamala Arudhra and Shreyas Kumar Sinha are the toppers with a score of 490, followed by Asmitha S. with 489 and Amirtha Varshini V. C. with 488.

Kavya Shivani has scored centum in Maths.

Amirtha Varshini V. C., Velayutham, Madhumitta and Belinda Carol have scored centum in Social Science.

Kamala Arudhra, Shreyas Kumar Sinha and Shreyas Rao have scored centum in Hindi.

GRADE 10 IGCSE RESULTS: PUSHPALATA BRITISH INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL

Pushpalata British International School has stepped into its 8th year with Class 12. In the first batch of Class 10 Cambridge Examinations, PBIS has secured one world rank and two National ranks.

Nivedha Sivakumar has secured 'Top in the World' rank in Mathematics with her centum and 'Top in India' rank with her 97% in Science. Sheena Abraham has secured 'Top in India' with her 97% in English. These children were honoured in a prestigious Cambridge Awarding Ceremony at Mumbai.

College, IIM - Indore, Stanley Medical College - Chennai, NIT - Trichy, Madurai Medical College, University of Kroningen - Netherlands, IISER - Thiruvananthapuram, MIT - Chennai, Tirunelveli Medical College, PSGTech. - Coimbatore, Loyola College - Chennai, Madurai Velammal Medical College, CIT - Coimbatore and SRM Medical College - Trichy.

III. AWARDS AND HONOURS

The Management, Staff and students of Pushpalata Schools take great pride and honour in announcing that Mr. E Harrison Jebakumar, Principal, Pushpalata Matric. Hr. Sec. School was conferred with the Dr. Radhakrishnan Award 2018. He received this award from the School Education Minister, Mr. K. A. Sengottaiyan, in an event organised by the Tamilnadu government at Kalaivanar Arangam, Chennai. This Award has brought great honour and pride not only to Pushpalata Schools but also to the entire Education District of Tirunelveli since Mr. Harrison is the only Principal of a Private School to have received this Award in 2018.

IV. INFRASTRUCTURE

Pushpalata British International School's mini-theatre is the latest of the technological resources added last year. The compact, air-conditioned auditorium here is another new facility, where 200 people can be seated.

This year, a new wing, the Annexe III, has been inaugurated for the Pushpalata Vidya Mandir primary section.

Children have participated in various Olympiad exams in Maths, English, Hindi, Science, Computer Science and General Knowledge conducted by Silver Zone, Unified Council and Science Olympiad Foundation in the campus, which provide them sufficient exposure and preparation towards excellence.

In all these Olympiads, children have been successful in securing very good scores. Among the participants, 93 won gold medals, 78 silver and 73 bronze.

166 students participated in NSTSE '19 and 30 children have received medals.

It is worth mentioning here that Tejasvini V. of Class XII has won the medal of distinction, and a cash award of Rs. 10,000/- in the International Company Secretary Olympiad, having secured the Zonal First position.

236 students participated in the SOF Talent Exam in various subjects. 33 students brought laurels by winning Medals.

Among the participants in various Olympiads, 29 won gold medals, 9 silver and 9 bronze.

In Spell Bee, 8 students were awarded gold, silver and bronze medals.

1. 33RD FOUNDER'S DAY

Mr. Akash, IAS, Sub-Collector of Cheranmahadevi, presided over the 33nd Founder's Day. More than 450 students participated in various cultural programmes on this occasion. English drama, Kite Festival dance, LED dance, Bharathanatyam, Mega dance and Tamil Drama were the important programmes.

On 26 January 2019, the 7th Annual Sports Meet of Pushpalata British International School was conducted. Smiley drill by the kindergarten, Food Chain drill by the primary kids, and Lezim drill by the Secondary students were the highlights. The overall sports championship was bagged by the Amethyst House.

4. MODEL UNITED NATIONS 2018

Model United Nations was organised at Pushpalata Vidya Mandir to create awareness on how the United Nations Council functions. Sixteen member countries were represented by their delegates. The Human Rights Council was portrayed with the agenda of 'Promotion of Gender Equity and Empowerment of Women'.

5. CURIO CITY 2018 - SCIENCE EXHIBITION

Dr. A. Selvin Samuel, Retired Associate Professor and Head of Department of Botany, St. John's College, inaugurated the Science exhibition -Curio City 2018- put up by students of Pushpalata Vidya Mandir. A variety of projects covering every field in Science, Technology and Mathematics, were exhibited. The Robo World, Forensic Experiment, Smart City, Maths Around Us, Agriculture, Bio-Diversity, Tech-Zone and Planetarium were some of the exhibits.

6. CROSS CURRICULUM PROJECT

Cross curricular learning this year in Pushpalata Matric. Hr. Sec. School was on the topic **Languages**. The Edu-Sports Partners League (EPL) is conducted for Classes 6 to 9 in order to involve every child in the games with a purpose of improving upon their team spirit and leadership.

9. TALENT DAYS

Talent Days for Classes 1 to 5 brought out the children's talents through cultural programmes on given concepts such as Importance of Water, Magic of Nine, Harmony, Imagination, Respect, etc.

10. MARGAZHI UTSAV

Margazhi Utsav was observed for the seventh year, to uphold the Indian tradition and culture. Children participated enthusiastically in activities and competitions such as kathakalashebam, story-telling, fancy dress, making kolams, drama, recitation of Thiruppavaai and Thiruvembavai, Bharathanatyam, Carnatic music, role play of characters from Mahabaratham, etc.

11. CAREER GUIDANCE PROGRAMMES

Several Career Guidance Programmes were organised for students of Classes XI and XII of Pushpalata Schools, which gave students a better view into what different careers entail and the steps that they need to take to get into such careers.

Around 200 photographs, captured by Photography Club members, depicting nature and varied concepts were exhibited in the campus. Professor Dr. Ramakrishnan inaugurated the exhibition and explained about the skills used by the students in each of the exhibits.

14. CLASH OF PI

319 students of Pushpalata Vidya Mandir participated in all the qualifying events of the Clash of Pi series - a Maths Online Quiz Contest, held every month. In the national level our school stands 14^{th} , among the 800 leading schools in India. We stand 6^{th} in the south zone.
